CHILDRENS COURSES - EVENINGS AND WEEKENDS:

Tuesday Progressive Riding Test / Challenge Awards Course 8 week course @ £300

Learn towards British Horse Society progressive riding tests and challenge awards- all levels of experience - riders will be spilt into levels to work towards appropriate achieve awards for their age and level of experience - includes riding and stable management weekly.

Sunday Pony Stars courses - 10 week course @ £310

Pony Stars and Horse explorers are the British Horse Society's Junior and youth Challenge Awards. It is aimed at helping 4-17 year olds to discover, develop and nurture their love for ponies and the outdoors. With over 100 topics for children to explore, Pony Stars and horse explorers will ignite a passion for ponies, build knowledge and cement friendships that will last a lifetime. Pony Stars will cover topics such as grooming, welfare, mucking out and riding skills. Horse explorers is aimed at teenagers and young adults, these awards help to develop your

confidence, skills and knowledge in a fun, supportive environment. Topics include horse care, riding fit, lungeing to name a few.It's not just about pony care and riding, the Pony Stars programme includes much more — covering valuable practical topics for children and young adults such as the countryside, farm animals, kindness, leadership & conservation. As part of the programme, each child will receive their very own Challenge Book to log their achievements. As they progress through the various challenges there will be stickers, badges, and rosettes to keep them engaged and motivated. There are four key groups, Shetland Striders, Dartmoor Dazzlers, Welshie Wizzers and Connemara Champs. This allows for long-term progression with a range of activities that will develop knowledge, skills, and self-confidence.
